I. Environmental Impact Assessment

- 1. Project description (a new project or an export related to an existing facility; details on the material change in the function of the existing project; etc.)
- 2. Participants and their respective roles.
- 3. Description of environment (geographical location of project, proximity to sensitive areas, social impacts etc.).
- 4. Classification (reason for the category used).
- 5. Basis of evaluation (documents, standards).
- 6. Detailed description of environmental impacts, by environmental element:
 - potential problems, adverse impacts
 - positive impacts
 - mitigation measures/alternative solutions, monitoring, etc.

The relevant concerned elements shall be evaluated in general (both for investment and operation stage):

- o Air
- o Water
- o Noise
- o Odour
- o Soil
- o Flora and fauna
- o Waste
- Municipality
- Hazard prevention
- o Social
- Other
