

Environmental and Social Impact Assessment

I. Environmental Impact Assessment

1. Project description (*a new project or an export related to an existing facility; details on the material change in the function of the existing project; etc.*)
2. Participants and their respective roles.
3. Description of environment (geographical location of project, proximity to sensitive areas, social impacts etc.).
4. Classification (reason for the category used).
5. Basis of evaluation (documents, standards).
6. Detailed description of environmental impacts, by environmental element:
 - potential problems, adverse impacts
 - positive impacts
 - mitigation measures/alternative solutions, monitoring, etc.

The relevant concerned elements shall be evaluated in general (both for investment and operation stage):

- Air
- Water
- Noise
- Odour
- Soil
- Flora and fauna
- Waste
- Municipality
- Hazard prevention
- Social
- Other
